

2010 Lake Country Soccer Splash Tournament Format and Tie Breaking Procedures

Teams in Pool Play 2010

- A. Each team will play two games on Saturday with the two team with best record advancing to the Championship Game. The other two teams will play in the Consolation game on Sunday.

****Special Note:** In the event two teams have identical record after Saturday's games and advancement to Championship or Consolation is not clearly defined by team's record, a tie breaker game may be played on Sunday morning to decide who plays in Championship Game and Consolation Game.

****If three teams have identical record**, there may be **two tie breaker games** on Sunday morning with the two teams who did not play each other on Saturday competing to see which teams advance to Championship Game and Consolation Game.

Teams in Round Robin Play 2010

- A. Tournament Champion and the team being awarded Second Place will be decided by:

- 1 Overall record.
- 2 Head to head competition.
- 3 Most Bonus Points.
(See *Bonus Points as listed.*)
- 4 Most shutouts
- 5 Fewest Goals Allowed
- 6 Most goals scored (Max of 3 per game)
- 7 FIFA Penalty Kicks

Championship Games 2010

- A. If a game is still tied after the end of regulation time, teams will play two (2) five minute overtime periods.
- B. Games still tied at end of the two overtime periods will be decided by FIFA Penalty Kicks.
